We are beyond thrilled to announce that we donated **\$30,700** worth of equipment and resources to the school this term.

This is a testament to our hard working team generating profits through fundraisers and tuckshop. And, of course, to you as TSS families, who support us and donate your valuable time and money.

We are pleased to announce we have donated the following to the school, to be purchased in Term 4:

- \$5000 towards banners and shade tents (with school name and emblem)
- \$700 for Story Champs (Reading Intervention)
- \$3,800 for Carpet Squares for classroom displays
- 5 classroom iPads, valued at \$4,250
- \$250 for Magnetic Minecraft building cubes
- \$5,500 for Early Years Climbing and Gross Motor equipment
- \$10,000 towards furniture for the Library
- \$1,200 for student gardening supplies
